

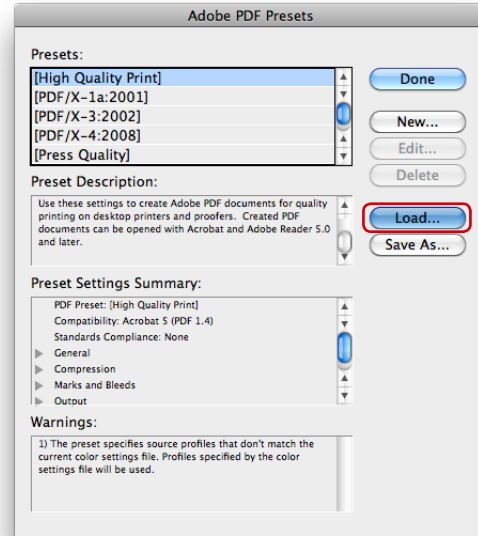

(CS4 and newer)

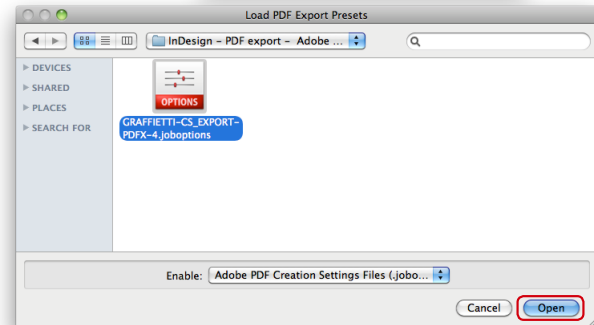
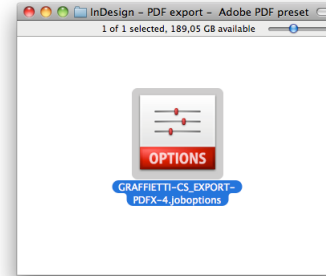
Please, follow the steps below:

- 1_ Choose **File > Adobe PDF Presets > Define...**
- 2_ Click **Load...** and select the file named as:
GRAFFIETTI-CS_EXPORT-PDFX-4.joboptions,
then click **Open** in the dialog box
- 3_ Click **Done** to exit



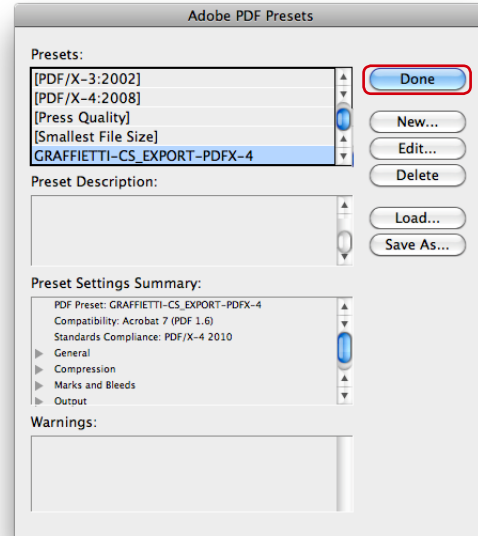

WE SUGGEST:

checking the color settings for the right printing condition.

FOGRA 39 (coated/matt paper) -> ICC profiles:

ISOcoated_v2_eci.icc / **ISOcoated_v2_300_eci.icc** or **CoatedFOGRA39.icc**

FOGRA 47 (uncoated paper) -> ICC profile:

PSO_Uncoated_ISO12647_eci.icc

converting spot colors to CMYK before exporting PDF

checking linked images to inspect for
resolutions below 300 ppi threshold (at 100% scale factor)

IT'S REQUIRED:

creating the bleed (3 mm, at least) for the objects
that extend beyond the edge of the page
