

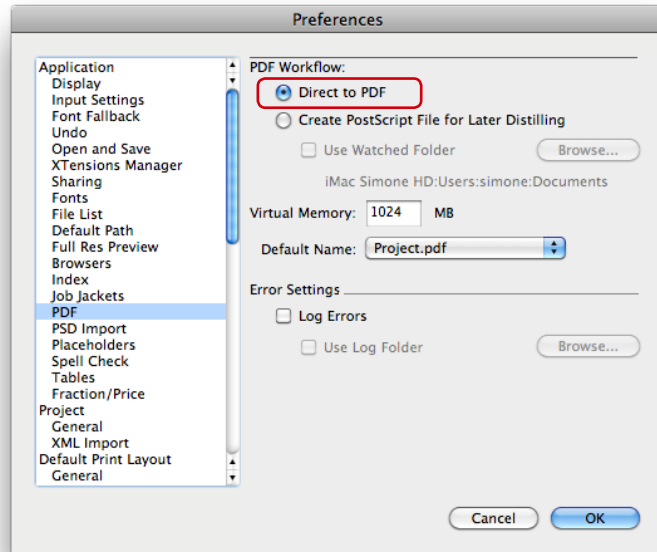

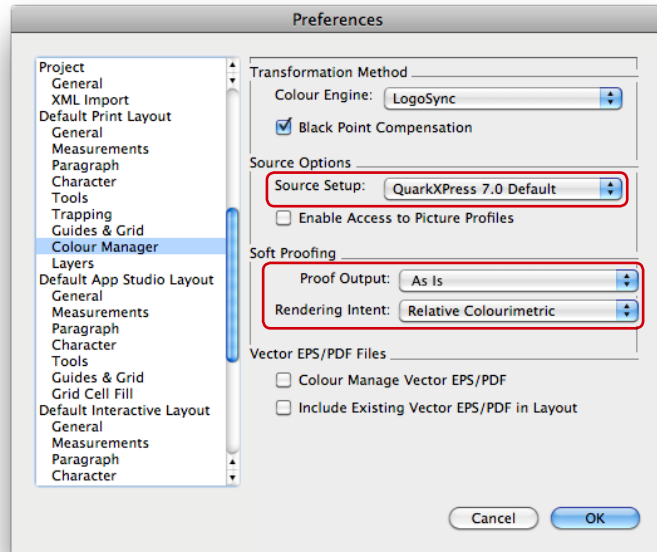
Please, follow the steps below:

- 1_ Choose **QuarkXPress > Preferences**
- 2_ Highlight **PDF** (under “**Application**”) in the list at left
- 3_ Click the check box **Direct to PDF**
- 4_ Click **OK** to confirm



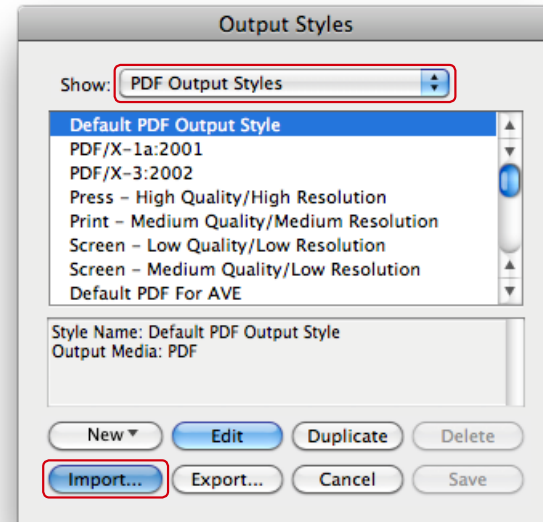
Please, follow the steps below:

- 1_ Choose **QuarkXPress > Preferences**
- 2_ Highlight **Colour Manager**
(under “**Default Print Layout**”)
in the list at left
- 3_ In “**Transformation Method**”
select the parameters as in the
screenshot on the right
- 4_ Click **OK** to confirm



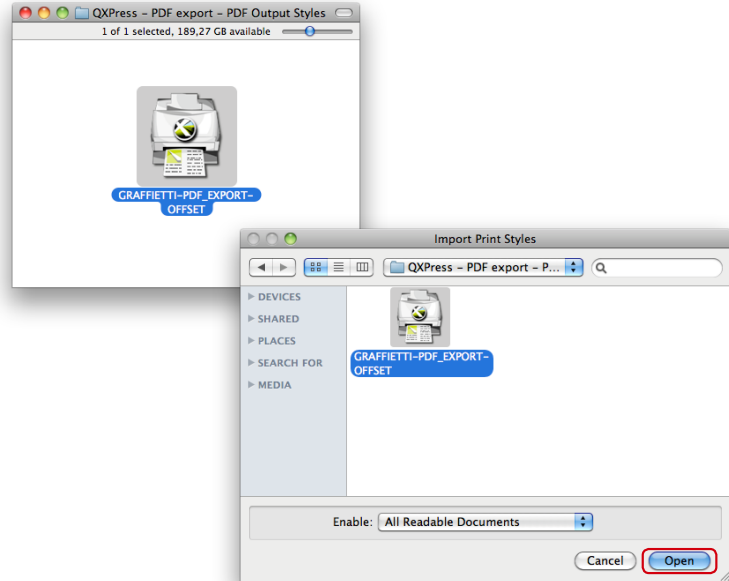

- 3_ Give a name to the file and click **Save**

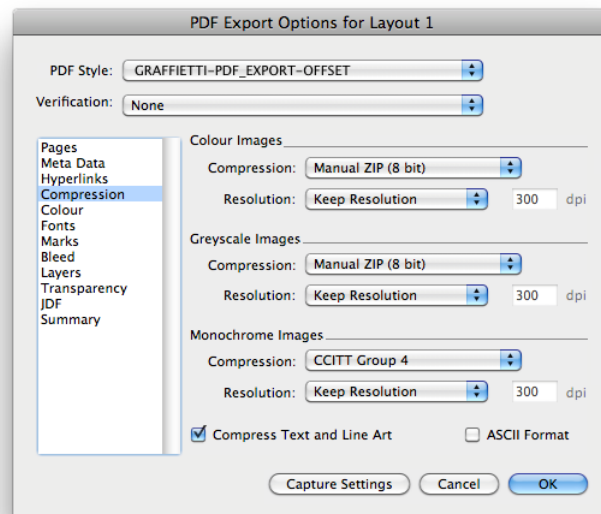
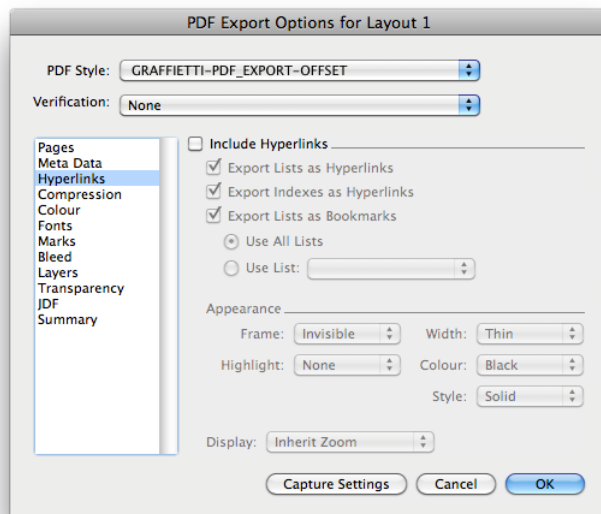

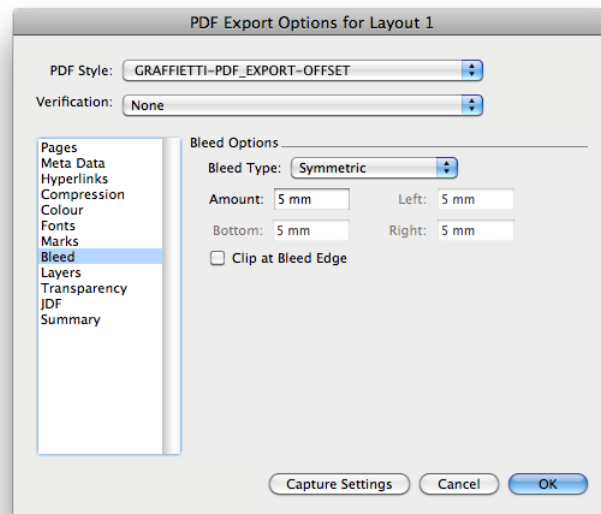

WE SUGGEST:

checking native and linked graphics for colours
others than CMYK (NO RGB or LAB allowed with these color settings)

converting spot colors to CMYK before exporting PDF

checking linked images to inspect for
resolutions below 300 ppi threshold (at 100% scale factor)

IT'S REQUIRED:

creating the bleed (3 mm, at least) for the objects
that extend beyond the edge of the page
